

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are and how Flipful SIA (hereinafter referred to as Flipful, we, us or our) uses them. You should read this policy to understand what cookies are, how we use them, the types of cookies we use i.e, the information we collect using cookies and how that information is used and how to control the cookie preferences. 1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer by the websites you visit. They are widely used to make websites more efficient and provide useful information to site owners, such as the number of site visits.

The use of cookies has become a standard practice in most websites. However, if you do not want to use cookies, you can manage and control them without agreeing to use certain cookies or by using your browser not to accept or delete them from your browser's history.

2. How do we use cookies?

Our website uses cookies managed by Flipful (first-party cookies), as well as third-party cookies based on your consent, except for required cookies.

Mostly, cookies are used on our website to find out whether you have agreed to the use of certain cookies, to identify the registered user, to find out the number of visitors, and to ensure the functionality of the website. If you are a registered user of Flipful, certain information may be linked to your account and registered user information. Cookies-related information is not used to identify unregistered visitors to the Flipful website.

3. What types of cookies do we use?

To ensure the functionality of our website, we use different types of cookies. Below are the types of cookies that can be placed in your browser.

Essential cookies: some cookies are essential for you to be able to experience the full functionality of our site, such as providing secure access to the accounts of registered users, remembering to consents given, etc. Without these cookies, the website cannot function and is therefore mandatory.

Functional cookies: These cookies help us store your settings and browsing preferences, such as language preferences so that you have a better and efficient experience on future visits to the website.

Statistics: These cookies allow us to recognize and track the number of our visitors and see how users use our site. These data help us understand and analyze how well the website performs and where it needs improvement.

4. How can I control the cookie preferences?

Most browsers (Firefox, Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, etc.) allow you to manage cookies through your browser settings. For example, you can set your browser to block cookies, delete existing cookies, or alert you when new cookies are placed.

By clicking on the "Help" menu in your browser, you can find instructions on how to prevent your browser from placing cookies, as well as viewing and deleting cookies that you have already saved, if you wish. Appropriate settings must be made for each browser that you actively use.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, please note that, without placing certain cookies (such as required and / or functional cookies), you may not be able to access all sections of the website or make full use of the features provided by the website. Many of the features of this website depend on the use of cookies.

5. Managing individual cookies

Some third-party cookie managers provide additional options for opting out of their managed cookie placement and / or obtaining information from relevant cookies.

For example, Flipful uses Google's "Google Analytics" made cookies to improve the quality of the website's content and to adapt it to the needs of users. If you want Flipful not to get information about your activities on the website, you need to activate Google Analytics.
